

Substance Use Disorder Treatment Programs: Safe Medication Storage



Substance Use Disorder (SUD) treatment programs play a key role in helping individuals to achieve recovery in a safe, therapeutic and supportive setting. Whether that is in group homes, halfway houses, detoxification, transitional living arrangements, sober living communities or outpatient centers, medication is an important part of their care.

In preparation for discharge, patients need to be taught self-care techniques, which includes responsibly caring for their medications to prevent important and expensive medications being stolen, or accidentally taken by young children.
